

3 Cuarto Casa de Campo en venta en Valor, Granada 240.000€













This is an exceptional cortijo, which was constructed 23 years ago, was built by a local builder for his own use. The build quality and materials used are of the highest standard and there are many outstanding features. The cortijo, traditional in appearance, was constructed using modern methods and is fully insulated.

The three bedroom property is located at an altitude of approximately 1650m and is set in 4.8 hectares of land. Access is via a 5.6km well used track, which means the use of a 4x4 is necessary. There is also an option to purchase a further 15 hectares of land adjacent to the property.

The main entrance to the property is an outstanding custom made wooden stable door, which leads into a large open plan kitchen/dining/living area. One of the features of this room is the huge chestnut ceiling beam, supported at either end by a chestnut tree trunk split in half. There are beautiful chestnut ceiling beams and stone flooring throughout the property. The attention to detail is extremely high, to the extent of using traditional style porcelain electrical sockets and light switches.

This room, the hub of the house, has a large open fireplace, fitted kitchen with huge solid chestnut worktop, large dining table and ample room sofas, display units etc. all the other rooms are accessed from here. This includes a useful store/pantry room, family shower room with antique style fittings, wc and porcelain washbasin.

There are two good sized double bedrooms with free standing furniture and a further larger bedroom with two double beds and a large free standing wardrobe.

A wood store is accessed from outside the property. The spacious area immediately around the cortijo is stone paved,
