The complex has a large swimming pool with lighting, walkways and large garden areas, ideal for enjoying the Mediterranean climate.

San Pedro del Pinatar is famous for its salt lagoons and its therapeutic mud baths, with recognised benefits for the health and beauty of the skin. The area is also ideal for outdoor sports activities, like golf, hiking, cycling and all forms of water sports on the beautiful beaches of the Mar Menor. The good road network makes it possible to reach various tourist areas in less than an hour, like Murcia and Cartagena on the Costa Cálida, and Orihuela Costa, Guardamar del Segura and Alicante on the Costa Blanca. Murcia airport is only 30 minutes away from the complex, and Alicante airport is 50 minutes away.
