A unique property for sale at an excellent price and perfect for investment. There are two 3 Bed Apartments, the one on the first floor has a good sized patio and the second floor has two balconies. The third floor is a big studio apartment with an amazing terrace with views of Sax Castle and a workshop. The owners of the block also own the shop on the ground floor and that can be discussed if it is of interest. It is a larger area than the apartments although they are not small at over 90m² and it could be converted into a three car garage and leave enough space to put in a small gym and a sauna, alternatively, it should rent out easily. The First Floor apartment is currently rented out but only on a month-by-month basis at 400€ per month. We would expect that after being painted white throughout and some LED lighting put in that long term rental should be in the region of 450€ per month, possibly a little more because of the location which is so close to Gran Via, the High Street in Sax. The Second Floor apartment we would expect a similar rental and for the Third Floor in the region of 375-400€ per month.
